Arctic Paper Munkedals AB Wood and raw materials

Arctic Paper Munkedals AB is sourcing wood raw material in form of cellulose pulp, used for our paper production, from various suppliers. Arctic Paper Munkedals AB is according to EUTR* acting as an operator when those raw materials are placed on the EU and UK market for the first time (i.e. when the sourcing is done from a non-EU or UK supplier) and as a trader when sourcing raw materials already placed on the EU or UK market by an operator. This document also secures the fulfillment of the UK Timber regulation.

As an operator we are obliged to have a DDS in place to secure that the pulp we source is compliant with EUTR and UKTR does not originate from illegally harvested timber. The DDS system will be monitored by the national authorities.

Arctic Paper Munkedals AB is FSC® FSC-C020637 and PEFC Chain-of-Custody PEFC/05-33-99 certified and all pulp we source is either FSC or PEFC certified. The PEFC certified pulp is in addition also FSC Controlled Wood certified.

Arctic Paper Munkedals AB is sourcing pulp from suppliers in the following countries: Sweden, Finland, Estonia, Portugal, Spain and Brazil.

The pulp Arctic Paper Munkedals AB is sourcing is produced from timber harvested in the following countries (if applicable, regions are noted in brackets): Sweden, Finland, Norway, Denmark, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, UK, Spain, Portugal, Uruguay (Sur-Este), Brazil (Tres Lagoas, Rio Grande do sul, Minas Gerais, Amapa).

The pulp Arctic Paper Munkedals AB is sourcing is made from the following species of wood:

Birch (Betula SPP), Eucalyptus (Globulus, Uro-Grandis, Nitens, Regnans), Pine (Pinus Sylvestris, Pinus Contorta), Spruce (Picea Abies, Picea Sitchensis), and Aspen (Populus Tremula).
